

Travel

Buses – Park and Ride all go to city centre, from Temple Meads no. 9 bus (tap on tap off costs £2 single)

Train – to Temple Meads, 20 minute walk to city centre or 10 minute ferry ride to city centre

Driving – park in Trenchard Street or Millenium Square car parks

Food and drink

There are numerous cafes on Park Street, more substantial meals in Canons Marsh / Millenium Square or in local pubs e.g

Pubs :Greenhouse (very close to LMC), Three Tuns (good beer) 5 mins walk, Christmas Steps (10 mins walk)

Cafes : Costa, Crafty Beans, Woodes, Cafe Lounge, Swoon (ice cream) all 1 min walk in Park Street, Boston Tea Party, Bristol City Museum slightly further walk Park Street plus numerous others

Food : stalls in city centre (opposite Hippodrome), Greenhouse or Christmas Steps pubs, Pizarova 30 seconds walk from LMC, 5 mins walk is Canons Marsh / Millenium Square with large number of eat in restaurants

Please note LMC has no catering facilities or public loos. Bristol Cathedral loos are available, suggested access via the cloisters at the rear of the building. Bristol Library (next door to Cathedral) has public loos
